

Powell *Sonaré*

Flutists agree the **MOST IMPORTANT FEATURES** of a flute are the **HEADJOINT** and **SCALE**. The headjoint must be responsive and flexible; the scale must be accurate and well balanced from the top register to the bottom.

HEADJOINTS

Powell Flutes have been made in the Boston area since 1927 and have always been known for “The Powell Sound” which, in large part, comes from headjoints made by the incredibly skilled headjoint makers at the shop.

Every Powell Sonaré flute is shipped with a Verne Q. Powell Flute Signature headjoint made completely of sterling silver. These headjoints are made at the Powell shop by the same headjoint makers who create the headjoints for Powell’s Handmade Custom flutes.

SCALE

The scale of a flute is determined primarily by the placement and the size of the holes on the body tube. Using Powell’s patented Zinki technology, every Sonaré model body is made at the Powell shop with the Modern Powell Scale — exactly the same scale used on the Powell Signature and Conservatory instruments.

The Powell Signature headjoint and Modern Powell scale assure that Sonaré model flutes bear a strong family resemblance to the Handmade Powell Flutes.

CHOICES

There are many model choices available that offer a variety of options. Choose traditional silver plating or elegant rose gold plating. Select Y-arms or French style pointed arms. Be bold and add a little rose gold on the lip plate. Whichever model you choose, the Powell Sonaré flute speaks like no other.

Sonaré has recreated that sound in the Sonaré alto flute. Now available with a curved headjoint, each Sonaré alto flute features a handcut headjoint made by Powell Flutes at the Boston area workshop.
